Overview

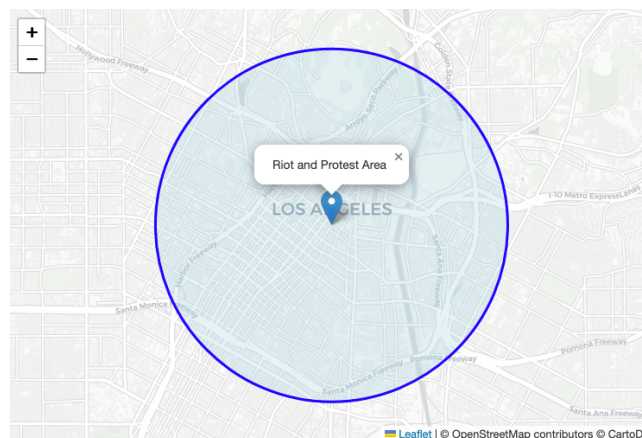
ServiceAreaMaps.com is a free online tool that lets you instantly create radius-based maps around any address. It's designed to help emergency response teams, news outlets, public health officials, and local governments communicate clearly and quickly in urgent situations.

- No account needed
- Shareable links and embeddable maps
- Downloadable HTML for offline use

Use it to define containment zones, evacuation radii, or coverage areas with ease.

Use Case Examples:

- **Emergency Containment Zones:** Quickly show the public which areas are impacted.
- **Evacuation Radius Maps:** Create clear zones for fire, flood, or hazardous material responses.
- **Power Outage / Boil Water Advisory Areas:** Help citizens know if they're affected.
- **Search & Rescue Coordination:** Organize teams around a central point.
- **Protest or Riot Boundaries:** Help define zones for safety, reporting, or curfews.
- **News Article Support:** Add simple, accurate visual maps to breaking coverage.
- **Coverage Maps:** Use for public service or utility coverage areas.



How to Use and Share Maps

1. Go to <https://ServiceAreaMaps.com>
 2. Enter any address and choose your radius.
 3. Click “Generate Map.”
 4. Copy the link to share or embed it with the provided code.
 5. Download the HTML file to archive or use offline.
